WHEREAS, on December 7, 2017, the Council of the City of Fresno ("Council") adopted Council Resolution No. 2017 - \_\_\_\_\_ calling a special mailed-ballot election on changing the types of Services and the rate and method of apportionment the special tax and authorizing the levy of a new Maximum Special Tax for Annexation No. 54 of Community Facilities District No. 11 ("CFD No. 11"); and

approved by more than two-thirds of the votes cast, in accordance with City of Fresno Special Tax Financing Law, Chapter 8, Division 1, Article 3, of the Fresno municipal Code ("City Law").

2. The Council declares Annexation No. 54 to be fully formed and the property within Annexation No. 54, to be subject to the levy of the new Maximum Special Taxes and the special tax lien described in Resolution No. 2017 - \_\_\_\_\_, and authorizing the levy of a new Maximum Special Tax therein, and Council Resolution No. 97-126, approving local goals and policies for Community Facilities Districts, as described in the amended Community Facilities District Report dated as of November 7, 2017, on file with the City Clerk.

3. The Council directs the City Clerk or designee to record a notice of special tax lien in the Office of the County Recorder, pursuant to City Law, no later than 15 days after this resolution is adopted.
