A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO VACATE A PORTION OF EAST COPPER AVENUE AT NORTH MILLBROOKE AVENUE AND A PORTION OF A PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT IN OUTLOT A AND LOTS 1 THROUGH 4 OF TRACT NO. 6099

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Council of the City of Fresno, State of California (the "City"), to order the vacation a portion of East Copper Avenue at North Millbrook Avenue and a portion of a public utility easement in Outlot "A" and Lots 1 through 4 of Tract Map No. 6099 reserved from a previous vacation, as shown on the attached Vacation Exhibit. City of Fresno Resolution No. 2009-138 vacated a portion of North Millbrook Avenue north of East Copper Avenue and reserved a portion as a public utility easement, and it also vacated a portion of public utility easement next to North Millbrook Avenue.

 when and where all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation may

appear before the Council and be heard in relation thereto.

- 2. The Council elects to proceed under the provisions of Chapter 3, commencing with Section 8320, of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law of the State of California (California Street and Highways Code Sections 8300 et seq.).
- 3. The Public Works Director of the City is directed to cause notices of the proposed vacation to be published and posted for the time and in the manner prescribed by the provisions of Sections 8322 and 8323 of the California Streets and Highways Code.
- 4. The Council preliminarily determines that a portion of the public street and utility proposed to be vacated is useful as a multi-purpose trail as shown on the attached Vacation Exhibit under applicable general, specific, or community plans and policies. If the Council does not rescind such preliminary determination, based on evidence or public testimony presented to it, orally or in writing, at or before the April 5, 2018, hearing, the Council may proceed to make a final determination, at the public hearing, that the public street be vacated as provided herein.
