

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fresno City Council, in accordance with the procedures of Chapter 14, Article 20 of the Fresno Municipal Code (FMC), will conduct a public hearing to consider amending Residential Permit Parking District 10 as described below:

- 1. Amending the boundaries of the district. The new boundaries include the streets listed below and depicted in the map:**
  - a. East Clinton, East Terrace, East Harvard, East Brown, and East Princeton Avenues between Freeway 41 and North Orchard Street
  - b. East Michigan Avenue between North Fresno Street and North Angus Street
  - c. North Thesta Street between East Princeton and East Clinton Avenues
  - d. North Mariposa Street between East Michigan and East Harvard Avenues
  - e. North Angus Street between East Michigan and East Clinton Avenues
  - f. North Orchard Street between East Princeton and East Clinton Avenues
  - g. Residential properties on the north side of East Clinton Avenue between North Angus and North Orchard Streets and between North Thesta and North Fresno Streets
- 2. Amending the hours of enforcement. It is proposed that a parking permit would be required to park on the streets between the amended hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m, Monday through Friday, excluding City-observed holidays.**
- 3. Fee. The parking permit fee remains unchanged, with the first permit free, and additional \$19.00 each.**

In response to COVID-19, City Hall Council Chambers and City Hall will be open to the public at limited capacity for City Council hearings to allow for social distancing. Any interested person may also participate electronically during the public hearing to speak in favor or against the project proposal, by either Zoom meeting or telephone with instructions provided on the City Council Agenda, and present written testimony at least 24 hours in advance, via an eComment or by email to [PublicCommentsPlanning@fresno.gov](mailto:PublicCommentsPlanning@fresno.gov) (cc [Melissa.Almaguer@fresno.gov](mailto:Melissa.Almaguer@fresno.gov)). All documents submitted to the City Council for its consideration prior to or at the hearing shall be submitted to the City Council at least 24 hours prior to the agenda item being heard, pursuant to the City Council rules and procedures, or they may be excluded from the administrative record of proceedings.

If you challenge the above applications in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues, you, or someone else, raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Parking Division of the Planning and Development Department and/or City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. The Planning Commission action on the proposed applications is advisory and will be forwarded to City Council for final action.
