RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION



*Presented to the City's Fleet Management Division
for receiving the ASE Blue Seal of Excellence*

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno's Fleet Management Division of the General Services Department has earned the Blue Seal of Excellence Recognition as prescribed by National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the quality of vehicle repair and service. In the case of government fleets, it additionally honors the hard work and dedication technicians provide to police officers, firefighters, public works, and other public sector employees; and

WHEREAS, in order to earn the ASE Blue Seal of Excellence recognition, a minimum of 75 percent of a shop's technicians must be ASE certified. In addition, there must be a certified technician in each area of service offered and agencies must renew annually confirming their professionals' certification status; and

WHEREAS, eighty-six percent of the 57 Fleet Management Division technicians are ASE certified, which exceeds the Blue Seal award benchmark. More noteworthy is that the division's mechanical staff includes 28 Master Technicians, representing the highest possible level of individual ASE recognition; and

WHEREAS, five of the Master Technicians are certified as both Master Automotive Technician and Master Medium/Heavy Truck Technician; and

WHEREAS, technicians face significant demands to efficiently and cost effectively maintain the City's diverse 2,500-plus unit fleet, which ranges from patrol cars to refuse trucks, street sweepers and other various fleet; and

WHEREAS, these City of Fresno professionals have proven their dedicated commitment to automotive service of excellence.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, Mayor Jerry Dyer, City Manager Georgeanne White, and Members of the Fresno City Council, recognize and congratulate the Fleet Management Division of the City of Fresno General Services Department.




