A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS (CAL ICH) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FAMILY HOMELESSNESS CHALLENGE GRANT FOR ACCELERATING EFFORTS BY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS AND CONTINUUMS OF CARE TO ADDRESS AND END FAMILY HOMELESSNESS BY MAKING FAMILIES' EXPERIENCES OF HOMELESSNESS RARE, BRIEF, AND ONE-TIME AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL REQUIRED IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) wishes to apply for and receive an allocation of funds through the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the California Interagency Council on Homelessness (hereinafter referred to as Cal ICH) has issued a Request for Applications (RFA) on March 01, 2022, for the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant established by Chapter 8 of Part 1 of Division 31 of the California Health and Safety Code (sections 50255 et seq.) (the statute). Cal ICH was created in 2017 to oversee the implementation of Housing First policies, guidelines, and regulations to reduce the prevalence and duration of homelessness in California. The Council's mission is to develop policies and to identify and coordinate resources, benefits, and services to prevent and work toward ending homelessness in California; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to submit an application to obtain a Cal ICH allocation of Family Homelessness Challenge Grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City shall submit to Cal ICH an application to participate in the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant in response to the RFA issued on March 01, 2022, which will request a funding allocation for an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 for services to address and end family homelessness by making families' experiences of homelessness rare, brief, and one-time.

2. If the application for funding is approved, the City hereby agrees to use the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant funding for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by Cal ICH and in accordance with program regulations cited above.

3. The City Manager, or designees, is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the City the application, the Standard Agreement, and any subsequent amendments or modifications thereto, as well as any other documents required by Cal ICH for participation in the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant, and any amendments thereto.

4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
