**FRESNO CITY PLANNING COMMISSION
RESOLUTION NO. 19953**

The Fresno City Planning Commission, at its regular meeting on April 15, 2026, adopted the following resolution relating to Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936:

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 62 of Chapter 15 of the Fresno Municipal Code (FMC), Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 is being considered at the direction of the City Council to change the name of Cesar Chavez Boulevard to the original street names of California Avenue, Ventura Street, and Kings Canyon Road along a ±6.9-mile street segment; and,

WHEREAS, the affected segment begins at the intersection of West Cesar Chavez Boulevard and South Marks Avenue and extends east to South Peach Avenue. The street name change does not apply to the half-mile street segment between South Hughes and South West Avenues, as that is located in Fresno County, and is already named West California Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2026, the Fresno City Planning Commission ("Commission") conducted a noticed public hearing to review the proposed street name change in accordance with Section 15-6204 of the Fresno Municipal Code and received a staff report, exhibits, and presentation with project related information and invited testimony with respect to the proposed request; and,

WHEREAS, in the staff report dated April 15, 2026, staff recommended that the Commission support the City Council request to change the street name of Cesar Chavez Boulevard to the original street names of California Avenue, Ventura Street, and Kings Canyon Road along a ±6.9-mile street segment, as allowed pursuant to Section 15-6204 of the Fresno Municipal Code and to approve the Finding of No Possibility of Significant Adverse Effect as prepared for Environmental Assessment No. P26-00936 dated April 15, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, during the hearing the commission heard testimony regarding the requested street name change; and,

WHEREAS, three members of the public provided testimony in support of the proposed street name change, including comments addressing the historical significance of the existing street names, and one speaker further requested that the streets instead be renamed in honor of Dolores Huerta; and,

WHEREAS, no one spoke in opposition of the proposed street name change application; and,

WHEREAS, a motion was made by the Fresno City Planning Commission to approve Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 and the finding of No Possibility of Significant Adverse Effect as prepared for Environmental Assessment No. P26-00936

dated April 15, 2026, as recommended in the staff report dated April 15, 2026, with the following additions:

- a. Kings Canyon Road, Ventura Street and California be designated as historic names;
- b. The City explore opportunities to provide financial assistance to individuals who may incur costs associated with changing their address, including the possibility of Council District budget allocations to help support the street name change;
- c. That all future street name change proposals be subject to thorough historical and contextual research prior to implementation; and,

WHEREAS, the motion was made by Vice Chairperson Bray but did not receive a second, and therefore the motion failed; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission subsequently made a motion to approve Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 and the finding of No Possibility of Significant Adverse Effect as prepared for Environmental Assessment No. P26-00936 dated April 15, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission hereby finds and determines that, in accordance with its own independent judgement, there is no substantial evidence in the record to indicate that Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 may have a significant effect on the environment and hereby recommends adoption of the Finding of No Possibility of Significant Adverse Effect dated April 15, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fresno Planning Commission hereby recommends to the City Council that Street Name Change Application No. P26-00936 be approved, as shown on attached Exhibit A.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Fresno City Planning Commission upon a motion by Commissioner Lyday, seconded by Vice Chairperson Bray.

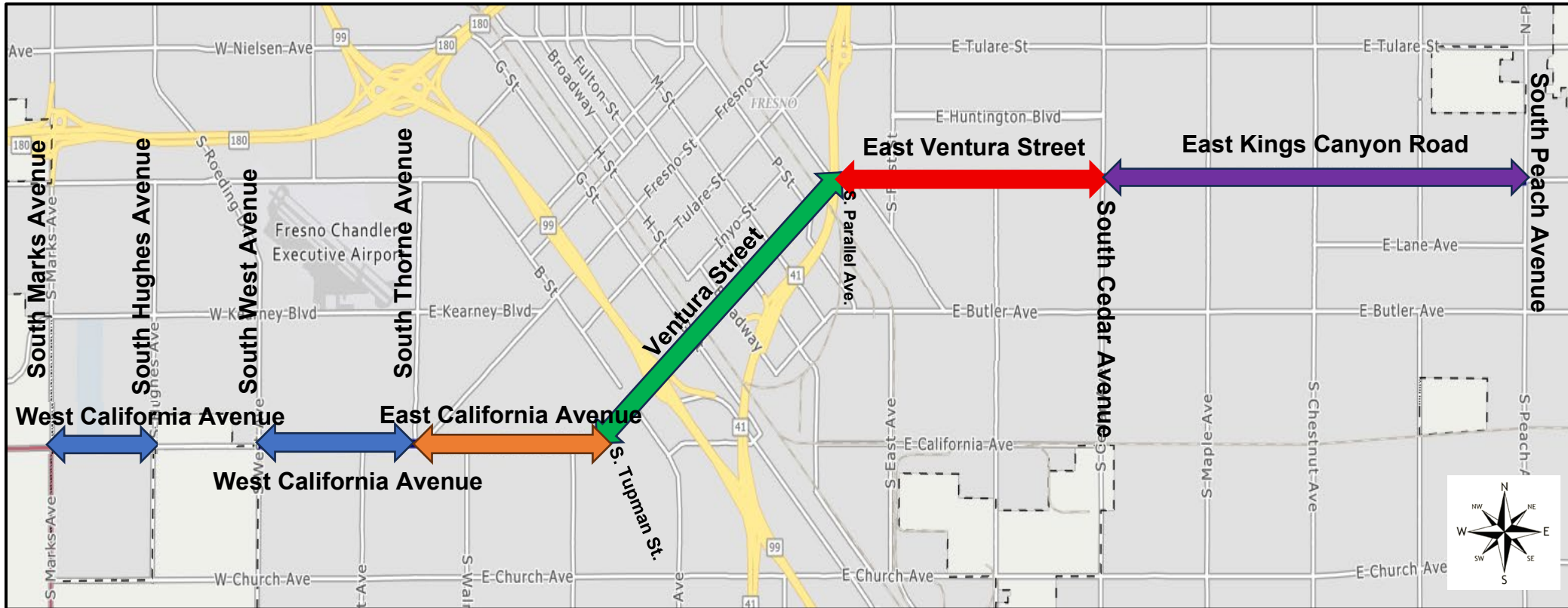
