The proposed work includes the removal of existing pedestrian heads at each intersection, which will then be replaced with countdown heads to provide pedestrians clear notice of when to proceed with crossing the intersections and how many seconds remain in the pedestrian (walk) phase so they know if they will have adequate time to get through the intersection. The engineering and design took approximately 12 months to complete.

DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract in the amount of \$214,934.00 to Pelagic Engineering as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
