A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH POWERSCREEN FOR A CHIEFTAIN 1400 TRACKED MOBILE INCLINED SCREENER WITHOUT ADVERTISED COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, City Charter section 1208 requires advertised competitive bidding for equipment involving the expenditure of City monies in excess of \$158,000, unless Council determines the goods to be supplied can only be provided by one source and the purchase is authorized by resolution of Council containing a declaration of the facts constituting the sole source; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Street Maintenance Division, is responsible for the construction, resurfacing, and repair, of approximately 1,740 miles of City streets and boulevards; and

WHEREAS, through the process of building and maintaining roadways, waste materials consisting of asphalt paving, gravel and dirt that must be separated and recycled; and

WHEREAS, a mechanical material sorting machine is used to take in dirt, concrete, and asphalt to produce sorted piles of clean dirt for reuse and waste material for recycling, sending less product to the landfill; and

WHEREAS, Powerscreen, the manufacturer of the Chieftain 1400 tracked mobile inclined screener, is the only manufacturer which meets the performance requirements of processing 400 tons of material per hour, highly mobile, and can be supported by a dealer network local to California; and

WHEREAS, the General Services Department and the Department of Public Works have researched alternative products and concluded that this is the only tracked mobile inclined screener of its kind; and

WHEREAS, the General Services Department, Fleet Management Division

recommends this purchase based on the particular needs of the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the new Powerscreen Chieftain 1400 tracked mobile inclined screen is \$401,361. This cost includes local sales tax of 8.35%; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has approved the proposed sole source purchase and the General Services Department now seeks Council approval of such purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council has received and considered the report and recommendations of City Staff.
2. The Chieftain 1400 tracked mobile inclined screen is the only product of its kind that meets the City of Fresno performance requirements.
3. Staff proposes to award a product purchase contract to Powerscreen in the amount of \$401,361.
4. Council hereby finds it is appropriate and necessary for the City to dispense with the competitive bidding requirement in this instance and to authorize the Purchasing Manager to purchase the Powerscreen Chieftain 1400 tracked mobile inclined screener under the sole source exception.
5. The General Services Director or designee is hereby authorized to purchase the equipment.
6. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
