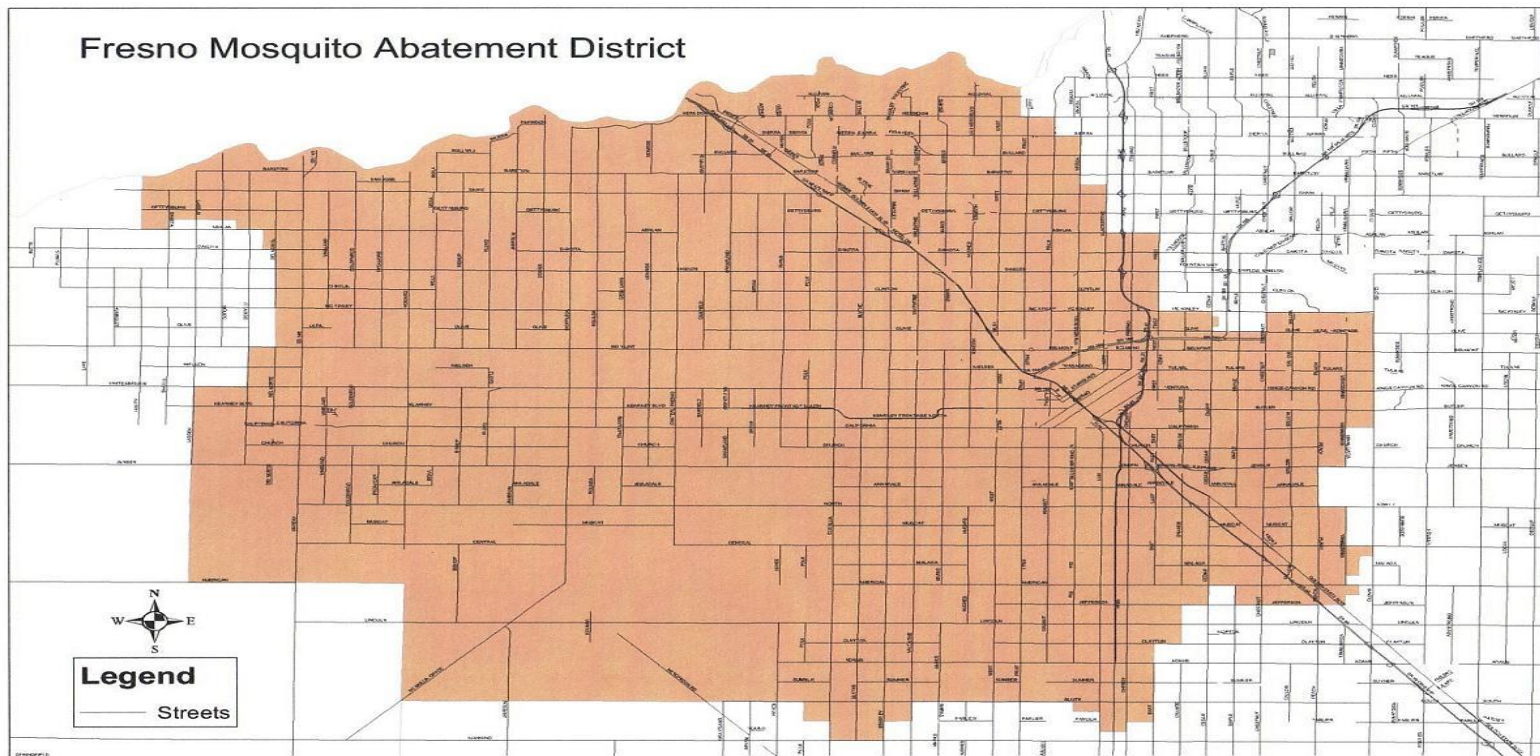

Fresno Mosquito & Vector Control District is a Non-Enterprise, Independent, Special District which was formed in 1942

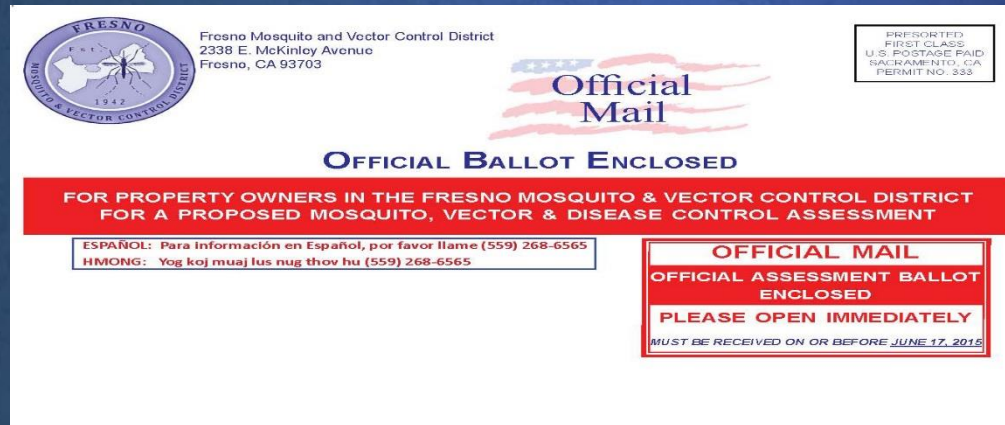


MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Fresno Mosquito and Vector Control District is to suppress populations of mosquitoes and other vectors of human disease, thus minimizing their disease-carrying potential, and reducing annoyance levels below generally acceptable thresholds.

BALLOT MEASURE

In early May, ballots will be mailed to property owners in the Fresno Mosquito and Vector Control District for a proposed Mosquito, Vector and Disease Control Measure.



If approved, the Measure will replace an existing Measure that will expire in 2017.

- Continue comprehensive mosquito and vector control services utilizing integrated pest management approaches to protect the public from the health risks associated with mosquitoes and other vectors.

2014 was a record year for West Nile virus activity in CA. 801 cases, 561 WN neuroinvasive disease, and 31 fatal WNV cases.



- Enhance the District's disease and population surveillance program.

Recent discoveries of a new mosquito species in Fresno County increases the potential of locally transmitted diseases such as Yellow Fever, Dengue and Chikungunya.



- Improve the District's Mosquito Fish program.

Mosquito Fish availability for urban and rural sources have been limited in recent years.



- Expand the District's public outreach program.

Without an informed and diligent public, there is little hope in our effort of controlling the new invasive species.
