A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, CONCERNING ASSEMBLY BILL 3218

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 3218 seeks State money for funding ongoing operations and maintenance of recreational facilities on the San Joaquin River; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 3218 also requires the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation to "take all necessary action" to acquire lands to expand the Millerton Lake State Recreation Area to include the San Joaquin River and approximately 5,900 acres adjacent to the river; and

WHEREAS, there is the potential for unintended consequences of this proposed legislation and "taking all necessary actions" may include exercising eminent domain of private property and may result in major impacts to local land authority and the jurisdiction of the San Joaquin River Conservancy and other local agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The Council supports AB 3218 if it provides only for the maintenance and operations of the San Joaquin River Parkway.
- 2. The Council opposes AB 3218 if it authorizes the State to use eminent domain and/or exercise regulatory land use authority over the San Joaquin River Parkway.
