### 4. MEMBER REPORTS AND COMMENTS

Board Member Harris announced that Resources for Independence Central Valley (RICV) is having a Community Gratitude Day event on Friday, April 25 from 3pm-7pm.

Board Member Harris asked if someone from council or mayor's office could speak at one of the Transportation meetings on what they would like the committee to focus it's efforts on as it pertains to paratransit and equal access and resources for the disabled community.

Board Member Grey gave a brief update on the progress of the Bus Stop project. Eighteen out of 75 bus stops have been completed so far. This project will continue through 2054.

#### 7. DISCUSSION

# Department of Transportation (PROWAG) Adoption

ADA Coordinator Joe Hinojosa gave the committee an update regarding the newly adopted PROWAG guidelines. On January 17, 2025, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) finalized a rule adopting the Public Right-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) for new construction and alterations of transit stops in the public right-of-way, making them enforceable ADA standards. Joe Hinojosa briefly explained to the committee how this will impact the City of Fresno.

#### R101.4 Effect on Existing Pedestrian Facilities

These guidelines do not address existing pedestrian facilities unless the pedestrian facilities are altered at the discretion of a covered entity. The Department of Justice has authority over existing facilities that are subject to the requirement for program access under title II of the ADA. Any determination that this document applies to existing facilities subject to the program access requirement is solely within the discretion of the Department of Justice and is effective only to the extent required by regulations issued by the Department of Justice.

#### R204.2 Alternate Transit Stops

Where accessible transit stops are temporarily not accessible due to construction, maintenance operations, or other similar conditions, alternate transit stops complying with R309 shall be provided.

ADA Coordinator Joe Hinojosa responded to questions from the committee.
