- WHEREAS, beyond her official role at Fresno State, Dr. Zelezny has remained dedicated to the pursuit of bettering the educational opportunities of Fresno students, working with the Fresno Rotary, an organization which awards much-needed grants to educational nonprofits in the area; and
- WHEREAS, in June of 2018, the Fresno State community will regretfully lose Dr. Zelezny in an official capacity as she moves on to her next challenge as President of California State University, Bakersfield. Her appointment to the presidency of Bakersfield State marks the first time a woman has been selected for this role, a historic and well-deserved achievement;
