A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO. CALIFORNIA. DECLARING AN URGENT NECESSITY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF HEALTH, PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY DESIGNEE TO **ENTER** MANAGER OR AGREEMENTS WITHOUT ADVERTISED COMPETITIVE THE **PREPARATION** BIDDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY REMEDIATION PLAN TO MITIGATE GAS EMISSION EXCEEDANCES AT THE NORTH SIDE OF FRESNO SANITARY LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) owns and operates the Fresno Sanitary Landfill (Landfill) located at 1707 West Jensen Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Landfill was placed on the National Priority List in 1989 due to migrating gases from years of receiving wastes of all types at an unlined sanitary landfill: and

WHEREAS, this project is under oversight of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) and the California Department of Toxic Substances; and WHEREAS, the Perimeter Probe MMW5B was monitored and detected methane gas levels exceeding the explosive limits; and

WHEREAS, US EPA has directed the City to prepare and implement an emergency remediation plan to mitigate the exceedances; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Landfill Gas Collection and Control System is essential for the health and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, further delays and proceeding through a formal bid process could have serious negative impact on the operation of the Landfill Gas Collection and Control System and the health and safety of the surrounding area and community at 1 of 3

WHEREAS, entering into agreements, without competitive bidding for various services, is necessary for the timely performance of the emergency remediation work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as

follows:

1. The foregoing facts constitute an urgent necessity for the preservation

of life, health, or property.

The requirement of advertising for bids is hereby waived pursuant to

Charter Section 1208(a).

3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to negotiate, enter and

execute service agreements, materials purchase agreements, and a construction

contract for the emergency remediation of the Landfill Gas Collection and Control

System, at a cost not to exceed \$611,679, with construction management cost not to

exceed \$50,000, for a total cost of \$661,679, subject to prior approval as to form by

the City Attorney's Office.

4. The Council finds the Project in the best interest of the City.

5. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
