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**AMENDMENT NO. 2
MEASURE C EXTENSION LITTER ABATEMENT PROGRAM
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
CITY OF FRESNO**

This Amendment No. 2 to the Cooperative Agreement for Litter Abatement (“Agreement”) is made and entered into, effective as of the Feb 10, 2021 (“Effective Date”), by and between the City of Fresno (hereinafter “GRANTEE”) and the Fresno County Transportation Authority (hereinafter “AUTHORITY”), a body politic duly organized and existing under the Constitution and the laws of the State of California.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, GRANTEE and AUTHORITY (hereinafter “PARTIES”) entered into the Cooperative Agreement for enhanced Litter Abatement Program (“LAP”) activities pursuant to Amendment No. 5 of the Measure C Extension Expenditure Plan; and,

WHEREAS on October 28, 2020, PARTIES entered into Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement to August 31, 2021, due to delays in commencing litter removal activities; and,

WHEREAS, the GRANTEE has been performing LAP activities along the SR 41, 180, 168 and 99 corridors within the GRANTEE’S jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the GRANTEE will exhaust the \$100,000 in matching funds originally provided to GRANTEE under the Agreement by May 14, of 2021; and,

WHEREAS, AUTHORITY implemented this LAP as a pilot to evaluate its effectiveness; and,

WHEREAS, to date, GRANTEE has removed over 59.07 tons of litter from these state highways as a part of this program; and,

1 WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY believes continuing this program with the GRANTEE for an
2 additional year is the best way to fully evaluate the effectiveness of the pilot program; and,

3 WHEREAS, the GRANTEE wishes to continue LAP an additional year; and

4 WHEREAS, the GRANTEE has submitted to the AUTHORITY an application for an
5 additional \$100,000 in funding for year two of the LAP pilot, which is to be matched by an
6 additional \$100,000 in Local Agency funding and in-lieu services, and an additional \$200,000 in
7 Caltrans funding.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the PARTIES agree as follows:

10 **TERMS**

- 11 1. The maximum cumulative not-to exceed total of LAP funding to be provided to GRANTEE
12 under the Agreement, as modified by this Amendment No. 2, will be \$200,000.
13 2. The term of the Agreement is hereby further extended through August 31, 2022.
14 3. GRANTEE will work with Caltrans to make any adjustment(s) to the separate agreement
15 between GRANTEE and Caltrans that may be necessary, consistent with GRANTEE's
16 obligations under the LAP Agreement, as modified by this Amendment No. 2.
17 4. All other terms and conditions contained in the LAP Agreement are unaffected by this
18 Amendment No. 2 and shall remain in full force and effect.




