AMENDMENT NO. <u>3</u> TO COOPERATIVE PROJECT AGREEMENT Short-Term Regional Transportation Program (STRTP) Project I3, Peach Avenue Widening, Kings Canyon Road to Belmont Avenue

This Amendment to STRTP Project I3, Peach Avenue Widening, Kings Canyon Road to Belmont Avenue is made and entered into the ____ day of ______, 2020 by and between the Fresno County Transportation Authority ("Authority") and the City of Fresno ("Responsible Agency").

1. <u>PARTIES</u>. The Authority and the City of Fresno are collectively referred to herein as "the **Parties**".

2. RECITALS.

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Cooperative Project Agreement for Project I3, Peach Avenue Widening, Kings Canyon Road to Belmont Avenue, ("Agreement"), dated June 1, 2009, for funding of a transportation improvement project ("Project") in Fresno County pursuant to the Measure "C" Short-Term Regional Transportation Program Handbook, subsequently replaced by the Measure "C" Strategic Implementation Plan (SIP), and the Fresno County Measure "C" Expenditure Plan ("Expenditure Plan"), which was approved by the voters of Fresno County in November, 2006; and,

WHEREAS, Authority is authorized to approve and revise Project funding for payment to Responsible Agency in accordance with the **Agreement**, the SIP and the Expenditure Plan regarding the Project I3, Peach Avenue Widening, Kings Canyon Road to Belmont Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of Project funding to Responsible Agency for eligible Project costs previously was revised by Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement, which was approved by Authority on October 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the amount of Project funding to Responsible Agency for eligible Project costs previously was further revised by Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement, which was approved by Authority on May 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, in Amendment No. 2, Authority agreed to provide funding to Responsible Agency for eligible Project costs "not to exceed" \$7,525,000 of Measure "C" funding.

- 2.2 The Parties now desire to amend the statements defining and delineating the Project Funding Program, as set forth in the original **Agreement**, and subsequently modified as set forth above, based on the following:
 - Responsible Agency has successfully completed the outlined scope of this project and now desires, by means of this Amendment No. 3 to reallocate \$2,278,400 in realized savings to Project I2B, Peach Avenue –Butler to Florence Avenues. Such reallocation will serve to provide a portion of the approved Measure "C" Regional Transportation Program ("Measure "C") funding for that transportation

improvement (Project I-2B), per the revised Exhibits as more thoroughly described in Section 3.1 of this Amendment No. 3. Approval of this Amendment No. 3 accordingly will decrease the maximum (not-to-exceed) amount allocated for this Project I-3 to the cumulative total of \$5,246,600 from the total funding amount authorized by the original **Agreement** as subsequently amended.

3. TERMS.

- 3.1 Exhibit "C" (Project Funding Program) to the original Agreement, as modified by the previously approved Amendments, as referenced in Section 1.1 of the original Agreement, and fully incorporated therein by the provisions of Section 3.23 thereof, shall be and is hereby replaced by Exhibit "C3" (Project Funding Program), which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, commencing upon the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement
- 3.2 All work performed by the Responsible Agency under the **Agreement** prior to the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 3 shall be governed by and compensated pursuant to the Original Exhibits and the **Agreement**. All work commencing on or after the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 3 shall be performed and compensated pursuant to the **Agreement** as amended herein.
- 3.3 <u>Effective Date</u>. The Effective Date of this Amendment No.3 to the **Agreement** shall be 12:01 a.m. of the day following the date upon which it is signed by the Parties. In the event this Amendment No. 3 to the **Agreement** is signed by the Parties on different dates, the Effective Date shall be 12:01 a.m. of the day following that date upon which it is signed by the second of the Parties.
- 3.4 All other terms and conditions contained in the Cooperative Project **Agreement** are unaffected by this Amendment No. 3 and shall remain in full force and effect.
