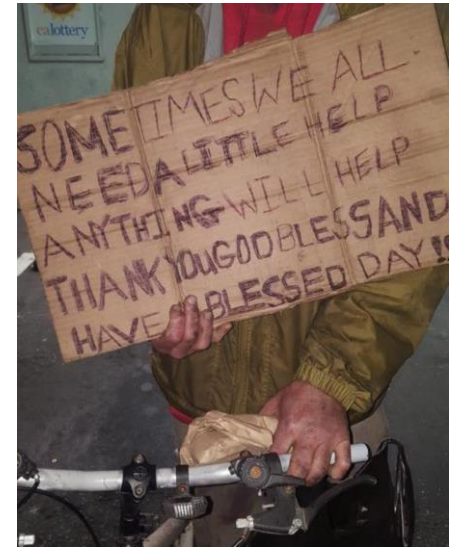

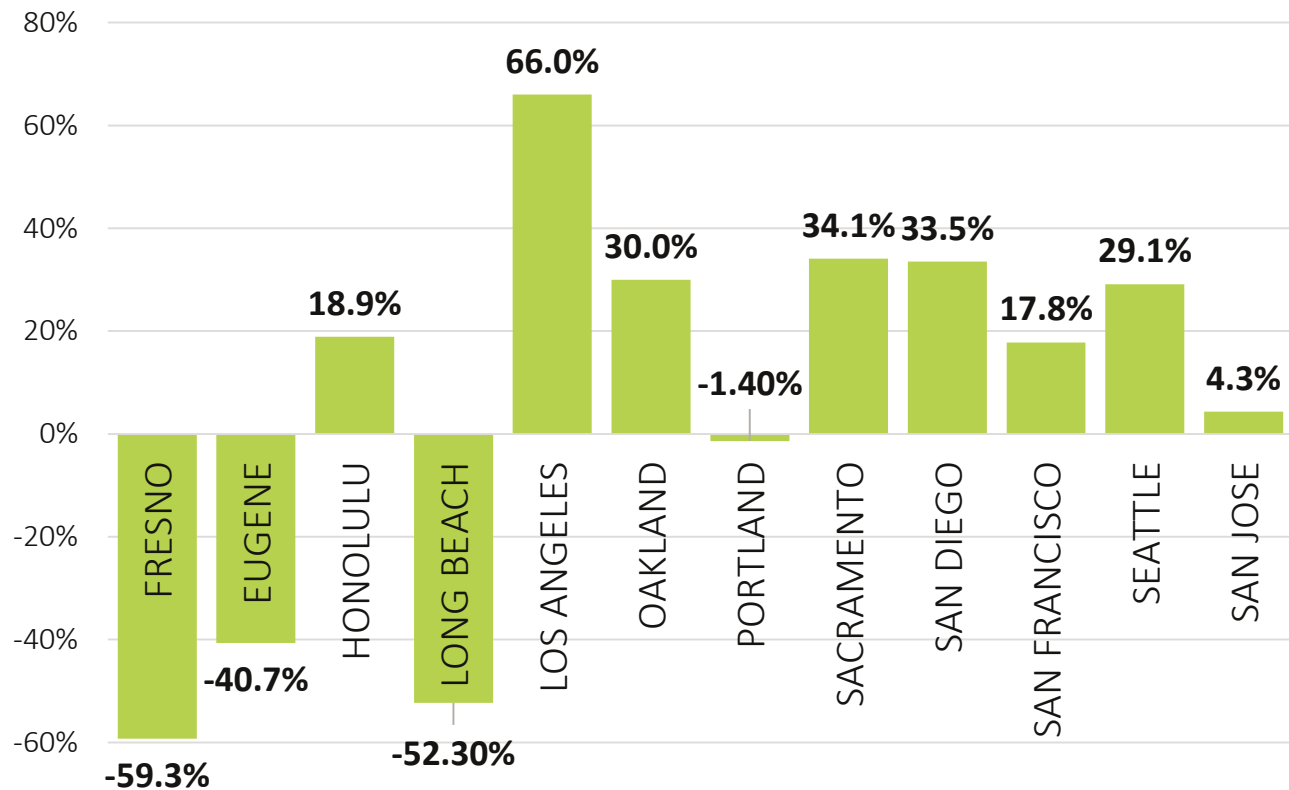

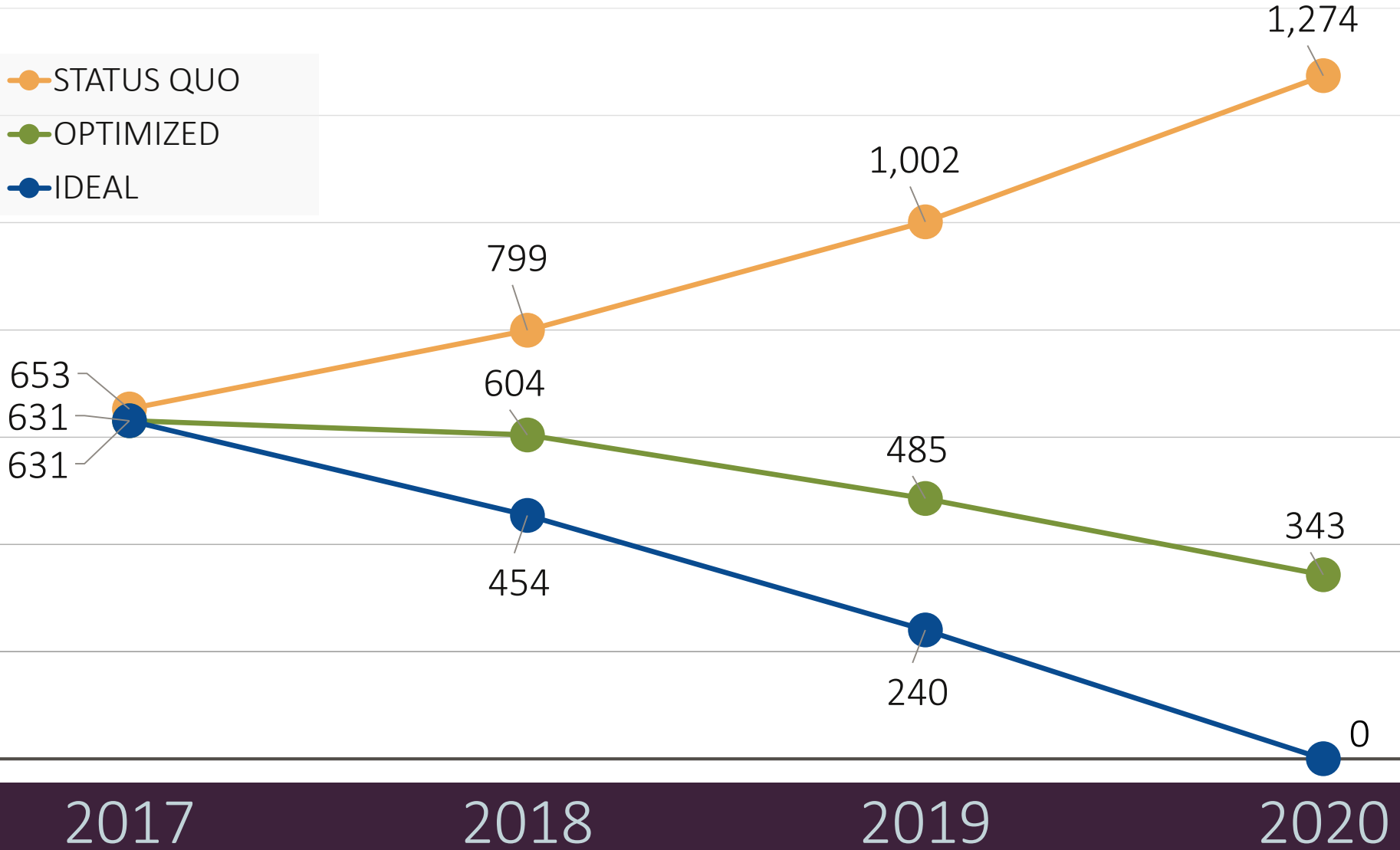
2010–2017

Establish Collective Impact Team

- + Mayor working with County Board of Supervisors to form leadership team
- + Engage cross-sector community leaders
- + Establish leadership structure for implementation and measurements of the plan
- + Align organization's strategies, resources and spending to eliminate duplication and enable efficient and free flowing collaboration
- + Strengthen the data foundation

Learning from the 9th Circuit's Boise Decision:

+ **The Street2Home Plan...**

- Positions our community to more humanely address the multi-faceted personal realities behind homelessness.
- Provides a systemic approach involving prevention, diversion, coordinated entry and crisis response with the end goal of permanent housing.
