

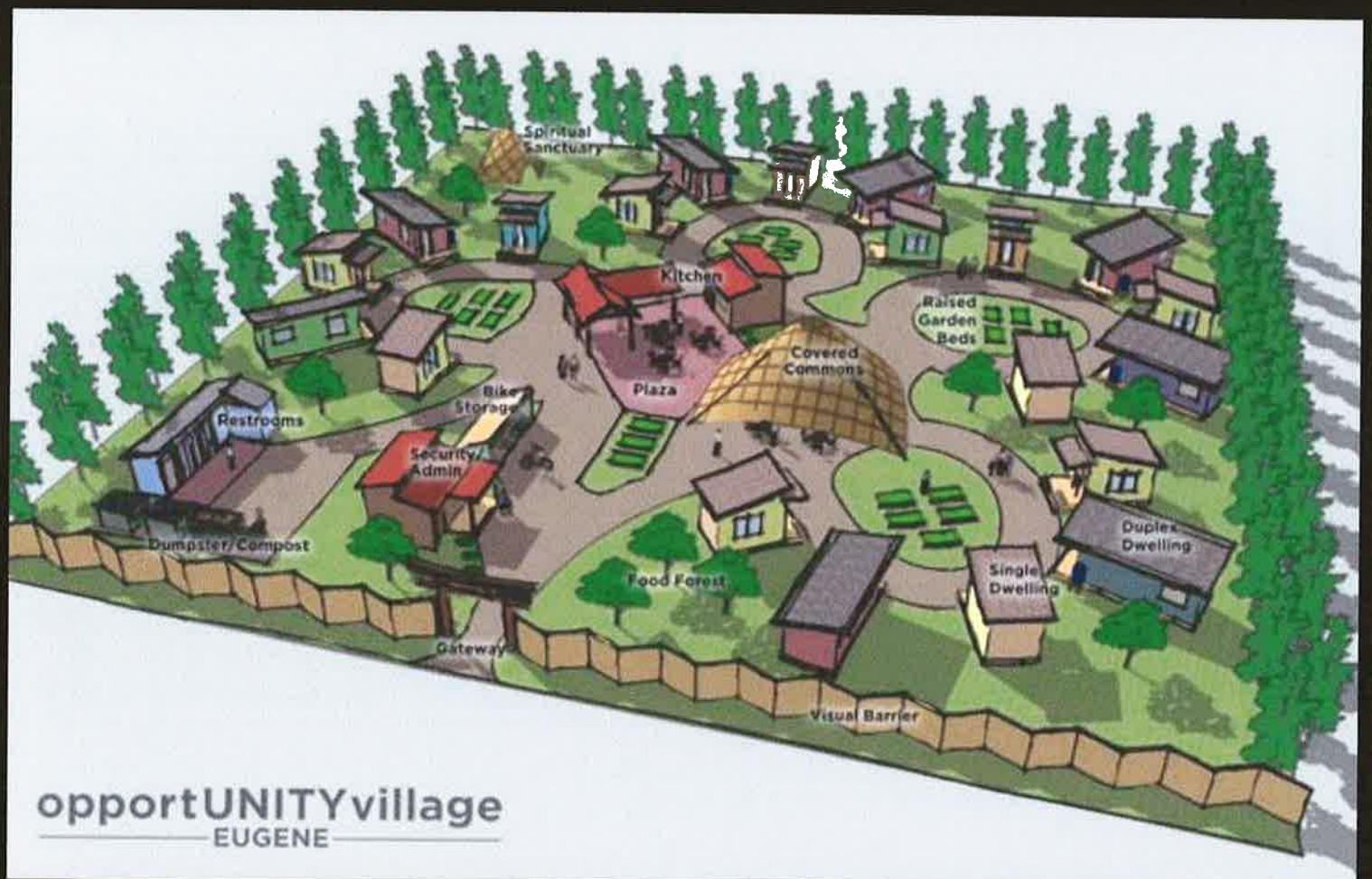

To All Concerned:

Let it hereby be known that on this day Thurs. April 28, 2016, it is recorded in the City of Fresno's City Council Clerk's minutes of this day's meeting, that it is the intention of the citizens of Fresno to set aside a minimum of 30 acres of land by city ordinance for the purpose of establishing and operating a homelessness mitigation project, to function as a city-wide architectural housing building materials and construction building materials research and development field research testing laboratory, in collaboration with the California State University – Fresno and it's related Colleges of Engineering, Social Sciences, Nursing and other Colleges as warranted and willing, for the additional purposes of establishing living quarters and ownership of homes on said land, to be sold to the homeless and occupied by them in the City of Fresno, California. Such properties will be chattel properties with the land real estate being owned and operated by the city, with economic and performance partners as needed, warranted and necessary.

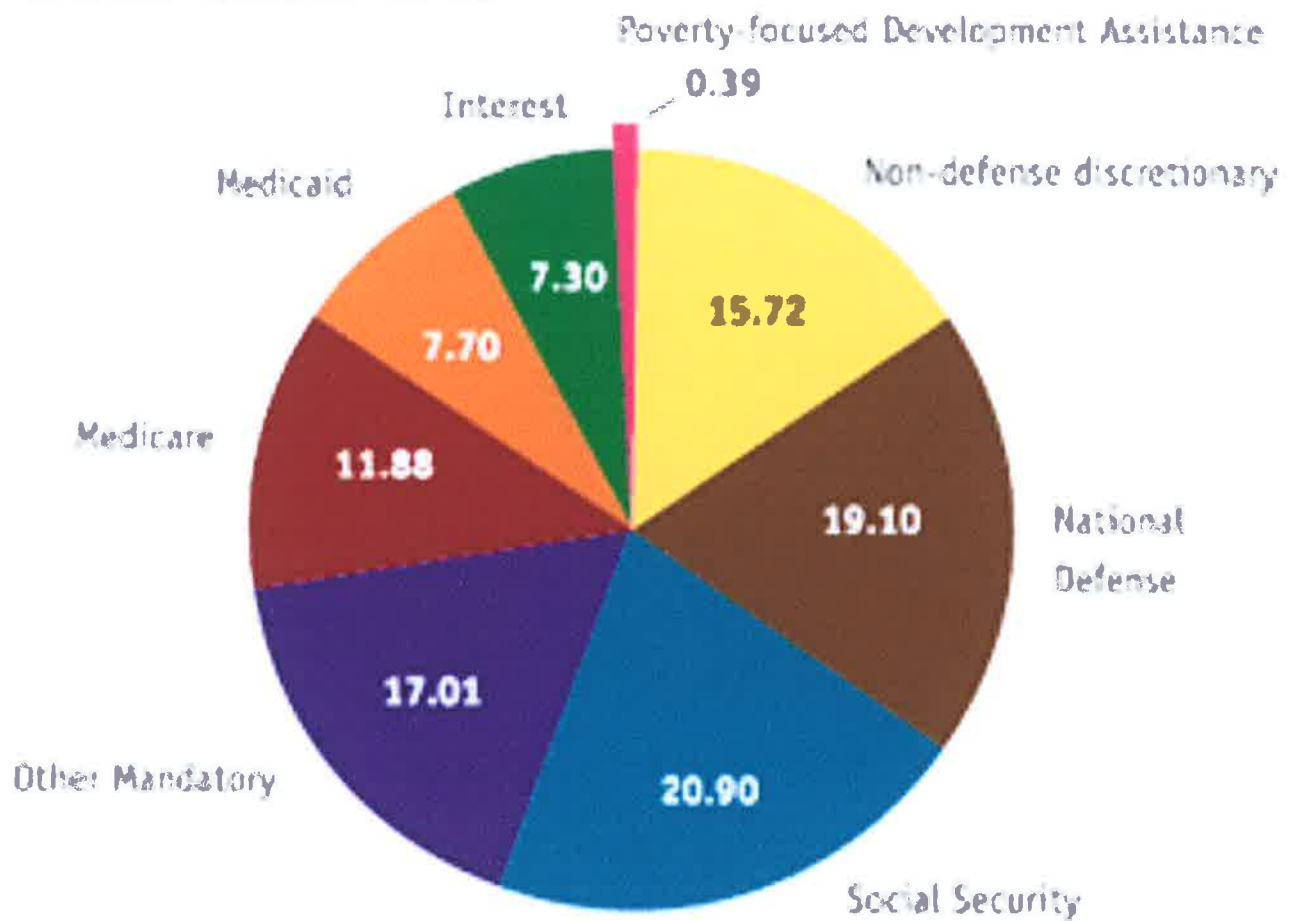
