- **WHEREAS**, Phil Roman, a resident of West Fresno and a graduate of San Joaquin High School is a gifted Mexican-American artist who is known worldwide for his outstanding career in animation that has earned him six Emmy awards; and
- WHEREAS, Phil Roman, who at the age of eleven first saw Walt Disney's "Bambi" at a local Fresno theater, and decided to be an artist who could bring drawings to life. Mr. Roman worked as an usher at Warnors Theater and in September 1949, Mr. Roman boarded a bus to Los Angeles with sixty dollars in his pockets to attend a cartoon and animation school; and
- **WHEREAS**, Phil Roman left to serve in the Air Force during the Korean War for four years and returned in January 1955 to continue his artistic education; and
- WHEREAS, Phil Roman was hired by Disney to work as an assistant animator on "Sleeping Beauty" in 1955. This adventure led Mr. Roman to San Francisco to work with Imagination, Inc and to Hollywood to work for Warnor Bros., MGM, and UPA. In 1984, Mr. Roman formed his own studio, Film Roman, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS, Phil Roman has won numerous honors and awards over the course of his career for various films and TV specials, including You're a Good Sport, Charlie Brown (1975), Life is a Circus, Charlie Brown (1980), Garfield on the Town (1983), Garfield in the Rough (1984), The Garfield Halloween Special (1985), Garfield's Babes & Bullets (1989), and The Simpsons TV Series (1992-1999). Mr. Roman most recently received the Pobladores Award from La Plaza de Cultura y Artes in 2021; and
- WHEREAS, beyond animation, Phil Roman is engaged and committed to the larger community as he has served on several boards and committees, including the U.S. Senate Republican Task Force on Hispanic Affairs and the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences; and
- **WHEREAS**, we celebrate Phil Roman for his outstanding contributions to the animation industry, his countless accomplishments, and his unwavering dedication to the arts & culture that has brought joy to many worldwide.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that we, Fresno City Council and Mayor Jerry Dyer, do hereby proclaim the 5<sup>th</sup> of October 2023 to be:
- "Phil Roman Day" in the City of Fresno.
