A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND  
PROCEDURES FOR PLACING MURALS ON CITY-OWNED  
PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno does not have a formal process to allow the public to request to place a mural on City-owned property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno has historically valued and supported local artists and their works; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to allow the public to apply to place murals on City-owned property; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires the City Manager to draft formal policies and procedures for the public to apply for and place murals on City-owned property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City Manager and the City Council will strive to work collaboratively to develop a process for placing artistic murals on City-owned properties.
2. Utilize the Fresno Arts Council as the screening body for the application process, if feasible.
3. This Resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
