A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT AND CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC VEHICLE IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAMS AND ACCEPTANCE OF PUBLIC BENEFIT GRANT FUNDS AND EXECUTION OF REQUIRED PROGRAM DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (SJVAPCD) and California Electric Vehicle Implementation Project (CALEVIP) have both authorized the establishment of the "Charge Up!" and the "Fresno County Incentive Project" (FCIP) providing funds for the purchase and installation of Electric Vehicle (EV) Chargers; and

WHEREAS, the CALEVIP and FCIP Programs assist public agencies with EV Charging acquisition and installation with clean air alternative charging options to promote the use of low or zero-emission vehicles in our communities; and

WHEREAS, the use of alternative fuel vehicles is beneficial for the City of Fresno and assists both the SJVAPCD and CALEVIP in attaining federal and state air quality initiatives including the CA Clean Air Act and Senate Bill 32; and

WHEREAS, the adopted procedures established by the SJVAPCD and CALEVIP require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application(s) prior to final submission of said application(s); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno EV Charging Pilot Program (Phase 1) includes the purchase and installation of up to (87) EV Level 2 Chargers and is consistent with the requirements of both the "Charge Up!" and "Fresno County Incentive Project"; and

The Public Works Director, or designee, of the City of Fresno is authorized to on its behalf to sign the Grant Application and Agreement, including any extensions or amendment thereof, subject to prior approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office. This authorization extends to amendments that add additional funds to the original agreement, subject to approval by this governing body of an amendment to the City's appropriations resolution.
