WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fresno (Council) adopted the Fresno Active

Transportation Plan (ATP) on March 2, 2017, as a comprehensive guide outlining the

vision for active transportation in the City of Fresno (City); and

WHEREAS, the ATP identifies over 166 miles of Class I trails as part of the

recommended active transportation network, designed to serve human-powered travel

including walking, bicycling, and wheelchair use; and

WHEREAS, utilizing Caltrans Sustainable Communities Grant Program grant

funds, the City engaged a consultant to prepare the Fancher Creek Trail Plan, a

conceptual study for trail feasibility, as well as promotional material and community

outreach; and

WHEREAS, the consultant completed a comprehensive feasibility study, Fancher

Creek Trail Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A, recommends conceptual layouts, plans to

fill the gaps in Fancher Creek's trail network, better connects residents to future transit

services, provides bicycle and pedestrian facilities to residents, and evaluates right of way

and construction estimates.
