A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO EXEMPT 8 RESIDENTIAL STREETS IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 2022-035, THE RESIDENTIAL STREET SPEED HUMP POLICY

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2021, the City Council rescinded a 2006 Pavement Undulation Policy which previously prohibited the installation of new speed humps on City streets, and directed staff to establish a new policy for the installation and removal of speed humps, also commonly referred to as speed bumps, speed tables, and pavement undulations; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2022, the City Council adopted a Residential Speed Hump Policy (Policy) outlining the process and procedures for the installation of speed humps; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Policy, applications for speed humps require the support of at least 75% of the addresses surveyed, and a minimum of 60% support from the occupied addresses along the block; and

WHEREAS, some applications have been unsuccessful in obtaining the necessary support required for a complete application; and

WHEREAS, residents regularly report speeding and request speed hump installations along their blocks; and

WHEREAS, safe and comfortable streets are a priority for the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, speed humps are an effective traffic calming measure on residential streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City Council exempts the following Council District 3 residential street sections from the Residential Street Speed Hump Policy, specifically those attached hereto as Exhibit A from the neighborhood support requirements.

2. The City Council directs staff to include the following speed humps as a traffic calming measure and use Public Works speed hump installation funding.

3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
