A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY AND FIRE PROTECTION (CalFire's) URBAN AND COMMUNITY FORESTRY GRANTS PROGRAM TOTALING UP TO \$1.5 MILLION IN FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT APPLICATION AND GRANT AGREEMENT DOCUMENTS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California in cooperation with the State Legislature has appropriated General Funds for the state's urban forestry programs; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Forestry and Fire Protection has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies and non-profit organizations under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection requires the City of Fresno ("applicant") to certify by resolution the approval of application before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out an urban forestry project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:


