WHEREAS, the Parties desire to continue program progress reporting for the extended Agreement period through December 31,2024; and

WHEREAS, with entry into this Second Amendment, the Agency agrees it has no claim, demand, or dispute against the City and affirms that it will abide by all obligations contained in the Agreement entered into on February 21, 2023.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals, which recitals are contractual in nature, the mutual promises herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree that the aforesaid Agreement be amended as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement referenced in section 3, shall be extended through December 31, 2024.
 - 2. The final report is due no later than January 15, 2025.
 - 3. The final invoice and all reporting is due no later than January 31, 2025.
- 4. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement, and all obligations contained therein remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict between the Agreement, First Amendment or any Exhibits and this Second Amendment, this Second Amendment shall control.
