The Construction Allocation for this expenditure is \$190,000. The contract price is 4.53% below the Construction Allocation.

**BACKGROUND OF PROJECT:**

The City of Fresno Department of Public Utilities, through the Collection System Maintenance workgroup is responsible for maintaining the City's sewer infrastructure consisting of over 23,600 access structures. The purpose of these structures is to allow access during inspection and cleaning of the sanitary sewers. Rehabilitation of these access structures will assist in extending the life of the existing system and eliminate structural deficiencies and corrosion caused by hydrogen sulfide. The project consists of rehabilitating ten access structures at multiple city locations.

The project was originally bid in FY17. Due to the Contractor's non-performance, the contract was terminated. Therefore, it was necessary to re-bid the project.
