A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL PLANNING AND DEMONSTRATION GRANT APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT AND EXECUTE ALL APPLICATION AND GRANT AGREEMENT DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FRESNO

WHEREAS, safe, convenient, and accessible transportation for all users is an adopted priority of the City of FRESNO; and

WHEREAS, one death on our streets is one too many; and

WHEREAS, crashes that result in death or serious injury are not inevitable but largely preventable and stem in part from human inattention and designs that are ineffective in accommodating multimodal uses in urban environments; and

WHEREAS, it is the role of government to do its part to serve and protect the populace; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno is designated as a Pedestrian Safety Focus City by the Federal Highways Administration (FHWA); and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning and Demonstration Grant Opportunity provides grant funds for eligible agencies for the purpose of improving roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through developing, completing, and supplementing the city's safety action plan; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation administers the Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning and Demonstration Grant and has requested applications from eligible agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno is eligible to apply for a maximum available funding of \$5,000,000 for the Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning and Demonstration Grant to further develop the city's safety action plan (Vision Zero Action Plan).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The Council authorizes the Public Works Director or designee to apply for a maximum available funding of \$5,000,000 from the United States Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning and Demonstration Grant Opportunity and participation therein consistent with constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution.
- 2. The Council certifies, consistent with constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution, that the City has or will have sufficient funds to provide the matching funds required.
- 3. The Council certifies that the City has reviewed, understands and to the extent consistent with all constitutional and local laws requirements and this resolution, agrees to the provisions contained in the application and program guidelines and related documents
- 4. The Director of Public Works or designee, is appointed as a representative of the City of Fresno to accept funding, execute and submit all documents including but

not limited to grant application documents and grant related agreements which may be necessary for the completion of the proposed project.
