MEANS AND METHODS FOR BID ITEM 9: SECONDARY INSPECTION

BIDDER: NATIONAL PLANT SERVICES, INC.

As clarified in Addendum 3, Question 4: "Pricing should be based on Contractor's intended means and methods to complete the work (in bid item 9)".

NATIONAL PLANT SERVICES RESPONSE: This document explains our means and methods for Bid Item 9 as directed in Addendum 3. **The Pricing in Bid Item 9 includes CCTV, LiDAR, and sonar inspection.**

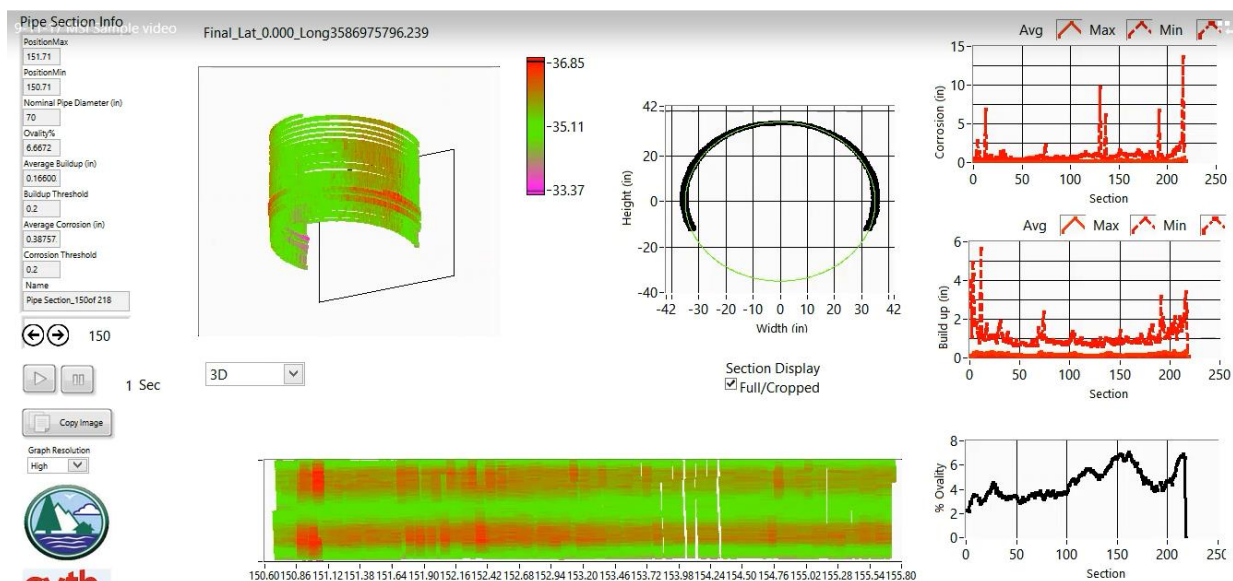
National Plant Services is an expert in multi-sensor inspections and has performed this service for many clients in California (see statement of qualifications for references). Multi-sensor inspections (MSI) are typically known to include a combination of the following sensors: CCTV, 3D Laser/LiDAR, and sonar. All sensors are deployed in a single robotic platform, so all sensors are collected in one inspection pass.

Our Carylton 3D LIDAR system is mounted on both a tracked and floating platform, with a high-quality custom A-Zoom camera, 3D Laser/LiDAR with Inertial Navigation System (INS), and Marine Electronics Sonar. The INS is a significant advancement over all other LiDAR platforms in the industry as the data from the INS is used to correct the laser readings depending on tractor/float movement, which provides extremely accurate laser profiling of the pipeline interiors, and greatly speeds laser processing. The platform can inspect from 30" to 120" (and larger) pipelines (see laser viewer example below).

The laser and sonar sensors simultaneously collect data as the operators are completing their normal PACP-coded CCTV inspection. The laser measures inside the pipe to determine the exact quantity of buildup or loss of pipe wall. The laser reporting for every inspection is very detailed, as the laser collects hundreds of thousands of measurements at each foot of scan. Sonar works under the water line to measure debris, which helps a City quantify cleaning needs, and to locate any large defects under water.

After CCTV inspection by NPS, all results will be reviewed by our in-house NPS Engineering Team, and recommendations provided where further inspection using CCTV, LiDAR, Sonar, and/or PPR is warranted. SewerVUE is our PPR subcontractor, and will perform PPR inspections as needed or desired by the City (see next page), at an additional cost.

National Plant Services, Inc. (NPS) is pleased to include SewerVUE as a team member for this project to perform any Pipe Penetrating Radar work that may be desired by the City of Fresno. Without a firm scope, SewerVUE could not provide a firm price, but general pricing and assumptions are shown below.

Please note that SewerVUE is a Canadian company, and does not have a California contractor license, nor a DIR number. NPS added SewerVUE to the project as directed by Section 2.01B of the Bid Specifications that called out PPR as a potential sensor requirement, and because of mentions to "SewerVUE" in other portions of the specifications.
