I served on the Events Committee. I conceptualized The Tower Arts Festival and worked with the Fresno Arts Council and the City of Fresno to make it a successful annual event for a number of years. I was member of the short lived downtown committee sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce and the City of Fresno in the 1990's. I am currently a board member of the Tower District Preservation Association. I presented a history of the Tower District Specific Plan to the current implementation Committee. I have a strong interest in city planning. I have worked with numerous neighborhood groups, business groups, nonprofits, and the City of Fresno to facilitated livable communities within Fresno.

Community Activism:

Prior to the Tower District Specific Plan, I with Michael Birdsong developed and circulated a petition that called for land use and zoning changes, design guidelines, a conscientious review of new developments, and a review of proposed building demolitions in the Tower District. The petition garnered broad support in the community. The petition was delivered to our Tower District Councilperson, Craig Scharton, who began the process of developing a Tower Specific Plan.

I was an Alternate on the Tower District Specific Plan Committee. After the Plan became an Ordinance in 1991, I became a member of the Community Public Works Committee, and worked with our Chair, Bruce Owdom, and others cooperatively with the City of Fresno to address Public Works issues.

In the 1990s I was a founding member of the Tower District Preservation Association (TDPA). The TDPA contributed \$30,000 to the City's Olive Avenue Landscape Project. For 7 years the TDPA co-sponsored with the Fresno Arts Council, The Tower Arts Festival. We worked with the City of Fresno to address the decline of Belmont Avenue. We hosted many positive events in the Tower District. I am Currently the TDPA President, and I am working with Brian Russell and Jill Aiello from City Public Works, as well as Mark Standriff from the City Beautify Fresno Team. The TDPA is interested in contributing a modest amount of money as well as volunteer efforts for a public works project in South Tower. The TDPA continues to explore ways that we can positively affect the Tower Specific Plan Area as well as the City of Fresno as a whole.

I have been attending nearly all the current Tower District Specific Plan Update Committee meetings.

On Saturday, 6-24-23 the City along with the Consultants working on the Plan Update held a community meeting attended by over 150 interested people. I along with Michael Birdsong facilitated the "Historic Preservation" station. I am scheduled to present/facilitate at a Specific Plan panel session and a mobile workshop that will occur in the fall of 2023. My understanding is that I will be part of the transportation/circulation presentation.
