BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The Collection System Maintenance workgroup is responsible for maintaining the City's sewer infrastructure amongst, including over 23,600 sewer access structures. These structures provide access for the inspection and cleaning of the sanitary sewers. Rehabilitation of these access structures will assist in extending the life of the existing system and eliminate structural deficiencies and corrosion caused by hydrogen sulfide, which off-gases from the wastewater flowing through the sanitary sewers. The project consists of rehabilitating seven access structures on Fruit Avenue between North and Jensen Avenues. The seven sewer access structures covered under this Project were identified through a facilities assessment investigation.

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DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract in the amount of \$553,700.00 to Floyd Johnston Construction Co., Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
