A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO CODE ENFORMCENT CONTRACTS OF \$100,000 OR LESS AND RESCINDING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 2019-179

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution 2019-179, delegating authority to the City Attorney to enter Code Enforcement contracts of \$50,000 or less; and

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement is housed in the City Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, delegated authority aids the City Attorney's ability to expeditiously enter into contracts to avoid any disruption of service; and

WHEREAS, to meet the demands of market inflation, contracting authority to the City Attorney for Code Enforcement contracts funded by the City Attorney's Office funds must be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Resolution 2019-179 is rescinded in its entirety.
2. The City Attorney is authorized to enter contracts of \$100,000 or less for Code Enforcement needs, paid for from the City Attorney's Office funds.
3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
