

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT (Amendment) made and entered into as of _____, 2026, amends the Agreement entered into between the CITY OF FRESNO, a municipal corporation (City), and HILL INTERNATIONAL, INC., a Delaware Corporation, authorized to do business in the State of California (Consultant). The City and the Consultant are collectively referred as the “Parties” in this Amendment.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an Agreement dated March 8, 2024, for professional construction management services for The Terminal Expansion Project, and

WHEREAS, City desires to amend the original scope of work to include additional on-call professional construction management services to support the delivery of Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and non-AIP funded capital projects at Fresno Yosemite International Airport (FAT) and Fresno Chandler Executive Airport (FCH).

AMENDMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Consultant shall provide additional construction management services as described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. Consultant’s compensation for performance of all services required or rendered pursuant to this Change Order Amendment shall be an amount not to exceed One million four hundred seventy-three thousand two hundred fifty dollars and zero cents (\$1,473,250.00), for a total contract value not to exceed Four million seven hundred eighty-four thousand seven hundred sixty-six and zero cents (\$4,784,766.00).
3. This Amendment shall become part of and subject to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, which except as modified herein, remains unchanged and in full force and effect. However, to the extent that the terms and conditions expressly set forth in this Amendment conflict with the terms and conditions of the Agreement, the terms and conditions expressly set forth in this Amendment will prevail. Unless otherwise defined in this Amendment, capitalized terms used herein shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Agreement.

B. Cost Qualifications / Notes

- This extension is structured as a Time-and-Materials (T&M) agreement with compensation based on actual hours worked and reimbursable costs incurred.
- Inspection personnel are compensated in accordance with State of California Prevailing Wage requirements.
- Services are anticipated to be performed during normal working hours, generally Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., unless otherwise directed by the Airport.
- The estimate does not include overtime premiums or shift differentials; compensation, if required, will be in accordance with applicable labor laws.
- Fully burdened Hill International labor rates are used based on Hill International’s audited field office overhead.
- Monthly invoices will include actual labor charges and reimbursable Other Direct Costs, including the Airport-requested MySmartPlans monthly maintenance charge.
- The proposed extension is contingent upon funding appropriation and authorization by the City of Fresno.
