A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND ARTS COMMISSION, TO CREATE THE EXPANDED ACCESS TO ARTS AND CULTURE SUBCOMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Arts Commission (Commission) was established pursuant to Fresno Municipal Code Chapter 7, Article 15, the “Fresno Clean and Safe Neighborhood Parks Tax Ordinance” (the Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the general purpose of the Commission is to provide fiscal accountability and citizen oversight relating to the development of parks within the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance requires that a percentage of the funds derived from the Ordinance be allocated to support and expand access to arts and cultural programming; and

WHEREAS, the Commission in partnership with the Fresno Arts Council, or its successor local arts agency, shall implement a program for the granting of funds to expand access to arts and cultural programming; and

WHEREAS the Commission now desires to create a subcommittee for the purpose of assisting and providing input and recommendations to the Commission related to Expanded Access to Arts and Culture Fund (EAAC) grant guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parks, Recreation and Arts Commission as follows:

1. The Expanded Access to Arts and Culture Subcommittee (Subcommittee) is hereby established.

2. The legal authority for creation of the Subcommittee is set forth in the Fresno Clean and Safe Neighborhood Parks Tax Ordinance and the Commission's Bylaws.

3. The Subcommittee shall be an advisory body.

4. The purpose of the Subcommittee is to assist and provide input and recommendations to the Commission related to Expanded Access to Arts and Culture Fund (EAAC) grant guidelines.

5. The Subcommittee shall dissolve upon the final adoption of the grant guidelines by the City Council.

6. The membership shall consist of no more than four Commissioners.

a. The PRAC Chairperson shall appoint the other member(s).

b. Term of Office. Members shall serve at the pleasure of the Chair.

c. The Subcommittee shall keep minutes and report back to PRAC at each PRAC meeting.

d. Membership revisions will be effective upon filing a new Organizational Form.

e. All meetings of the Commission shall be subject to the Brown Act.

7. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
