A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO MAKING THE NINETEENTH AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 2025-177 ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO ESTABLISHING RULES FOR THE APPLICATION OF CITY EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION RATES AND SCHEDULES AND RELATED REQUIREMENTS, AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES AND SCHEDULES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Fresno, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Exhibit 7, Unit 7 – Non-Supervisory Groups and Crafts (IBEW), is hereby amended to provide salary increases for respective classes as required by the adoption of the successor Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (Non-Supervisory Groups and Crafts – Unit 7), effective May 18, 2026.

SECTION 2.

Exhibit 7, Unit 7 – Non-Supervisory Groups and Crafts (IBEW), is hereby amended to provide salary increases for respective classes as required by the adoption of the successor Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (Non-Supervisory Groups and Crafts – Unit 7), effective June 15, 2026.

SECTION 3.

Upon final legislative approval, this Resolution shall become effective May 18, 2026.
