### **Request for Proposals Evaluation Committee Report**

#### I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Transportation/Fresno Area Express (FAX) sought to establish a contract with a towing service company to provide towing services for our fixed-route bus fleet. A Request for Proposals (RFP) solicitation was prepared and advertised to perspective bidders on July 11, 2025. Copies of the specifications were requested and distributed to eight (8) prospective proposers.

FAX included the following criteria to assess proposals:

- Past Performance and Experience: [35%]
- Price: [30%]
- Technical Approach and Reporting: [20%]
- Knowledge and Approach of Required Regulations [15%]

On August 12, 2025, FAX received three (3) proposals which were reviewed and deliberated by the Selection Committee. The results of the Selection Committee's evaluation are as follows:

As Eppler received the highest overall average score, the Selection Committee unanimously recommends them for award of RFP 12600085, Bus Towing Services.

### IV. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee evaluated the proposal based on four categories:

## Past Performance and Experience: [35%]

Demonstrated experience and history in bus or heavy-duty vehicle towing services relevant to FAX's needs. Performance on contracts of similar size, scope, and complexity. Quality and relevance of references provided. Awards, recognition, or commendations received for past performance.

### Price: [30%]

Pricing score is based on the lowest price in relation to the price offered.

## Technical Approach and Advantageous Solutions: [20%]

Approach to ensuring safe, and timely towing services. Quality assurance procedures and response time capabilities to meet FAX's needs. Also included is Proposer's methodology to response calls, and standard equipment used in operating procedures.

### Record Keeping Procedures [15%]

Proposer demonstrates knowledge of accurate recordkeeping and maintains a proper reporting approach, including past documentation or current data-tracking systems such as online report access capability as well as data collection and presentation as it relates to client towing services.

### VII. RECOMMENDATION

After independent evaluation of the proposals and group deliberation, the Selection Committee determined that Eppler Towing meets the interest of the City and the objectives of the services. The Committee recommends awarding a two-year contract, with options for three (3) one-year extensions to Eppler Towing for a total not to exceed \$335,500.00 for the two base years of the contract. The three (3) one-year optional extensions will be tied to a CPI for yearly increases, but the total will not exceed \$1,100,000 for the five possible years.

## **Department Recommendation**

Background (Explain the need for the procurement below.)

FAX operates a fixed-route bus fleet of 138 heavy-duty compressed natural gas (CNG) battery electric buses (BEBs), and hydrogen fuel cell electric buses (FCEBs), which provide 363 days of transit service to the residents of the City and County of Fresno each year, accruing over 34,000,000 vehicle miles.

When a bus becomes inoperable due to mechanical failures, accidents, etc., it is imperative that FAX has a tow truck vendor be able to answer our call to get the bus off the road and towed back to the yard as soon as possible. FAX needs a tow operator that is dependable and experienced to assist especially if there are any safety concerns such as a bus stuck in the middle of the road or barricading major entrances/exits to schools and/or hospitals.

Award a contract as follows:

Eppler Towing & Recovery	\$161,250 for year 1 (FY26) \$174,250 for year 2 (FY27).
