BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

In 2009, the State of California adopted a recycled water policy establishing a mandate to increase the use of recycled water in California by 200,000 acre-feet per year by 2020 and by an additional 300,000 acre-feet per year by 2030. The Recycled Water Master Plan prepared by the Department of Public Utilities' Wastewater Management Division (Division) identifies opportunities to assist with compliance of this law by reducing groundwater pumping and replacing groundwater with recycled water for non-potable purposes (i.e. outdoor irrigation, dust control, fountains, etc.). The Division's long-term goal is to produce and deliver 25,000 acre-feet of recycled water to the City's service area to reduce groundwater over drafting. On April 11, 2013, the City Council adopted the Recycled Water Master Plan and associated environmental documents. On June 27, 2013, the City Council approved a design contract for the Recycled Water Distribution System (RWDS), Southwest Quadrant starting at the Fresno/Clovis Regional Wastewater Reclamation Facility.

This project is the first phase of the RWDS in the Southwest Quadrant which will convey tertiary treated recycled water from the Fresno-Clovis RWRF into town for state approved urban non-potable reuse, groundwater recharge, and agricultural reuse. The recycled water is needed to meet the state mandated use of recycled water to offset potable water use in the City. The use of recycled water will also enhance the sustainability and reliability of the water supply.

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
DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:


