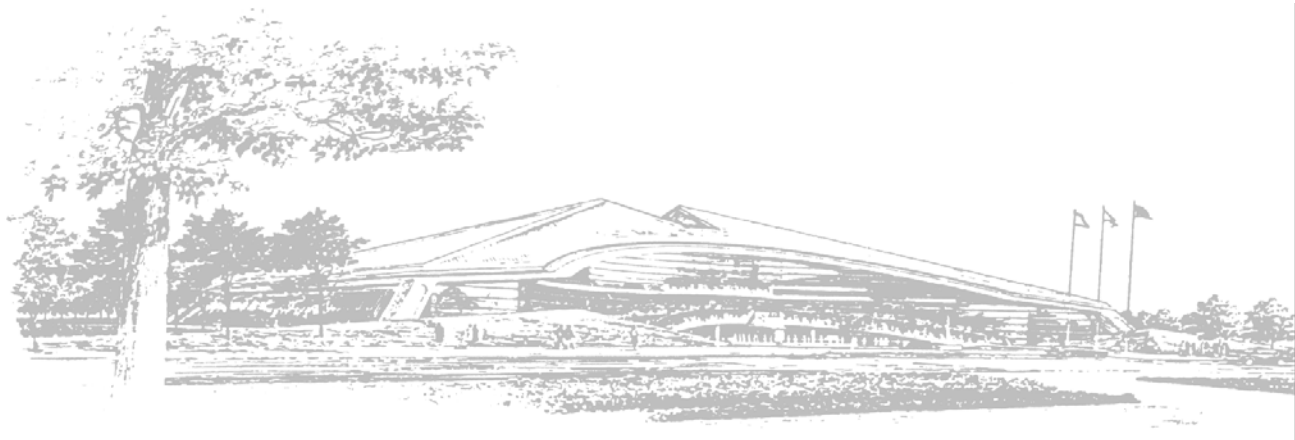


City of Fresno
