A. Planned Amendment - Rezone No. P22-05405

Plan Amendment & Rezone Application No. P21-05405 was filed by Gary Clark and pertains to the 2.15 acres located at 5524 E. Laurite Avenue. Plan Amendment & Rezone Application No. P21-05405 proposes to rezone the 2.15 acres from RS-4 (Medium Low Density) to RS-5 (Medium Density). The related Vesting Tentative Tract Map Application No. P21-03139 requests authorization to subdivide the land into a 17-lot residential unit development.

Related Tentative Map Tract Application No. P21-03139: Vesting Tentative Tract Map No. 6352 (P21-03139) was filed by Patricia Rawlings and pertains to the 2.15 acres located at 5524 E. Laurite Avenue. The proposed map is a request to subdivide the property into a 17-lot residential unit development. The related Plan Amendment & Rezone application (P21-05405) proposes to change the land use and zoning from RS-4 (Medium-Low Density) to RS-5 (Medium Density) in order to facilitate the density proposed on the subject site.
