The Department has issued the NOFA for Homekey grant funds pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 50675.1.3 (Assem. Bill No. 140 (2021-2022 Reg. Sess.), § 20.).; and

WHEREAS, City of Fresno (Applicant) desires to apply for Homekey grant funds.

Therefore, Applicant is submitting of an application for Homekey funds (Application) to the Department for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to administer Homekey pursuant to the Multifamily Housing Program (Chapter 6.7 (commencing with Section 50675) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code). Homekey funding allocations are subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, the Application, the Department- approved STD 213, Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement), and all other legal requirements of the Homekey Program.

- 1. Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to submit an Application to the Department in response to the NOFA for Homekey grant funds in a total amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 for the acquisition, rehabilitation, and operation of 817 N. Parkway Drive (APN 449-335-25) and 1804 W. Olive Avenue (APN 449-231-11) as interim housing.
- 2. If the Application is approved, Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver a Standard Agreement in a total amount not to exceed \$15,000,000, any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to secure the Homekey funds from the Department and to participate in the Homekey Program, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the Homekey Documents) subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
- 3. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that it shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the Standard Agreement, and that the NOFA and Application will be incorporated in the Standard Agreement by reference and made a part thereof. Any and all activities, expenditures, information, and timelines represented in the Application are enforceable through the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for the allowable expenditures and activities identified in the Standard Agreement.
- 4. The City Manager, or his or her designee, is authorized to execute the Application and the Homekey Documents on behalf of Applicant for participation in the Homekey Program.
 - 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon final approval.
