A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT A RESIDENTIAL
STREET SPEED HUMP POLICY

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2021, the City Council rescinded a 2006 Pavement Undulation Policy which previously prohibited the installation of new speed humps on City streets, and directed staff to establish a new policy for the installation and removal of speed humps, also commonly referred to as speed bumps, speed tables, and pavement undulations; and

WHEREAS, safe and comfortable streets are a priority for the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, speed humps are an effective traffic calming measure on residential streets; and

WHEREAS, residents regularly report speeding and request speed hump installations along their blocks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City Council adopts the Residential Street Speed Hump Policy attached hereto as Exhibit A.
2. The City Council directs staff to include speed humps as a traffic calming measure and use the Residential Street Speed Hump Policy to install speed humps when requested according to the provisions contained therein.
3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
