WHEREAS, the Council has elected to proceed under the provisions of the Public

Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law (Division 9, Part 3 of the

California Streets and Highways Code), and specifically Chapter 4 (commencing with

Section 8330) thereof, to summarily vacate a portion of an alley between East Tyler

Avenue and State Route 41, as described in Exhibit "A" and as shown on Exhibit "B"

which are attached and incorporated in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, Martin Park, Inc., is requesting the proposed vacation of a portion of

an alley between East Tyler Avenue and State Route 41, as described in Exhibit "A" and

as shown on Exhibit "B" which are attached and incorporated in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS the purpose of this proposed vacation is to accommodate development

associated with site plan number P21-03180 for the development and construction of

Webster Park; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Engineering Services Division has reviewed this

proposal and determined the proposed vacation of a portion of an alley between East

Tyler Avenue and State Route 41 as described in Exhibit "A" and as shown on Exhibit "B"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The public interest and convenience require, and it is hereby ordered, that as of May 26, 2022, a portion of an alley between East Tyler Avenue and State Route 41, as described in Exhibit "A" and as shown on Exhibit "B" be vacated.
- 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Resolution and shall file a certified copy, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of the City of Fresno, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of Fresno, State of California.
- 3. The City Clerk shall file a certified copy of the resolution for recordation in the Office once all work associated with this requirement has been accepted by the City Engineer or the Public Works Director.
 - 4. This vacation shall become effective on the date this resolution is recorded.

EXHIBIT "A"

Legal Description

That portion of Lots 7 through 10 and Lots 21 through 24 in Block 7 of the Map of Lisenby Tract, in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno State of California, according to the map thereof recorded on June 8, 1908, in Book 4 of Record of Surveys at Page 29, Fresno County Records, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Southwest corner of said Block 7; thence South 89°32'33" East, along the South line of said Block 7, a distance of 117.17 feet, to a point on the Northwesterly Right of Way line of California State Highway 41 as shown on the State Highway Map Book 4 at Pages 79 through 105 and State Highway Map Book 5 at Pages 1 through 9, on file with the Fresno County Surveyor, said point being the beginning of a 770.00 foot, non-tangent curve, concave Northwesterly; thence Northeasterly, from a tangent which bears North 57°06'19" East, along said curve, through a central angle of 0°42'02", an arc distance of 9.41 feet to a point on the West line of said Lot 21, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence North 00°30'02" East, along the West line of said Lot 21, a distance of 140.80 feet; thence North 47°18'13" East, a distance of 17.42 feet to the Southwest corner of said Lot 10; thence North 00°30'02" East, along the West line of said Lot 10, a distance of 8 feet; thence South 89°32'18" East, parallel with and 8 feet North of the South line of said Lots 10 through 7, a distance of 83.02 feet to a point being 4.1 feet West of the East line of said Lot 7; thence South 00°28'50" West, parallel with and 4.1 feet West of the East line of said Lots 7 and 24, a distance of 16.00 feet to a point being 8 feet South of the North line of said Lot 24; thence North 89°32'18" West, parallel with and 8 feet South of the North line of said Lots 24 through 21, a distance of 83.03 feet to a point being 12.7 feet East of the West line of said Lot 21; thence South 00°30'02" West, parallel with and 12.7 feet East of the West line of said Lot 21, a distance of 135.94 feet to a point on said Northwesterly Right of Way line, said point being the beginning of a 770.00 foot radius non-tangent curve concave Northwesterly, a radial to said beginning bears South 34°44'40" East; thence Southwesterly, along said curve, through a central angle of 1°08'57", an arc distance of 15.44 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.**

Containing 3,137 square feet, more or less.
