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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA BUSINESS, CONSUMER SERVICES AND HOUSING AGENCY'S (BCSH) CALIFORNIA INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS (CAL ICH) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE ENCAMPMENT RESOLUTION FUNDING PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL REQUIRED IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the California Interagency Council on Homelessness (Cal ICH) was created in 2017 to oversee the implementation of Housing First policies, guidelines, and regulations to reduce the prevalence and duration of homelessness in California; and

WHEREAS, Cal ICH is mandated to coordinate funding while also promoting systems integration to increase efficiency and effectiveness of the homelessness response system at the state and local level; and

WHEREAS, Cal ICH issued a Request for Applications (RFA) on October 29, 2021, for the Encampment Resolution Funding (ERF) Program established by Chapter 7 of Part 1 of Division 31 of the California Health and Safety Code (sections 50250 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) timely responded to the BCSH RFA for the ERF Program for local demonstration projects that provide services to address the immediate crisis of experiencing unsheltered homelessness in encampments, to support people living in encampment onto paths of safe and stable housing and result in sustainable restoration of public spaces to the intended uses while safeguarding the needs of unhoused people seeking shelter; and
