Whereas:

Born in Jackson, Mississippi in the mid-50s John Lee Walker fell in love with radio. He met Sharon, his wife of 41 years in Fresno and has two children, Ashlyn and Justin. From an early age, he began listening to Chicago radio from over 600 miles away. He says listening to that radio is what inspired him to enter the industry, and eventually, he got his first shot at an on-air role at WJXN in Jackson. Soon after, John was crowned "Jackson's Best DJ," and as a "reward" was given the chance to take on 7'3", 700-pound, Victor the Wrestling Bear at the Mississippi State Fair in front of a crowd of fairgoers. Needless to say, Victor won that match; and

Whereas:

His radio career spanned both coasts with stops in New Orleans, Tucson, Miami and Los Angeles, before finally settling in Fresno in the early 80s. John's popular Fresno-focused morning show (John Lee Walker in the morning) featured prominent Fresno State Bulldogs of the time, including Kevin Sweeney. In the late 1980's, after moving on from an on-air role, John opened a radio research firm in Fresno. He produced two locally-grown, music-based television shows, Rockin' Central Valley in 1986, and Rockin' California in 2003; and

Whereas:

A fervent supporter of the Central Valley, John is a regular supporter of Bulldog athletics, and during the construction of the Save Mart Center in the early 2000s became an Arena Builder. For a decade, John helped craft young athletes as Defensive Coordinator for the San Joaquin Memorial football team, helping lead them to a Valley Championship in 2004. His players would tell you that it wasn't the defensive schemes they'll remember from his coaching, but the life lessons he was able to pass along; and

Whereas:

His exploits in the radio industry, for better and for worse, have been documented in the digital docuseries "The Face for Radio," which is a self-deprecating and honest look at his radio career in the 70s and early 80s.
