A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO FUND THE FRESNO CITY COLLEGE TINY HOME CONSTRUCTION PARTNERSHIP

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) expressed an interest in ensuring residents have access to safe and habitable housing; and

WHEREAS, the City's most recent federal Annual Performance Report on Housing showed severe underproduction of homes for low-income families; and

WHEREAS, public and philanthropic funding to subsidize affordable housing is scarce and insufficient to meet the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to develop innovative partnerships to produce an increased number of affordable housing units while utilizing fewer scarce resources; and

WHEREAS, Fresno City College specializes in providing career technical education in the field of construction; and

WHEREAS, Fresno City College's students have a history of building affordable housing for Fresno low-income residents; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, the City unveiled its One Fresno Housing Strategy which outlined 47 priorities to address Fresno's three-year housing needs; and

WHEREAS, one of the 47 recommendations contained within the One Fresno Housing Strategy placed priority on encouraging the development of accessory dwelling units and tiny homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as

- 1. The Fresno City College Tiny Home Construction Partnership shall be funded with a one-time allocation in an amount not to exceed \$850,000, subject to a future funding agreement approved by council, from the City's American Rescue Plan Funds, to enable Fresno City College students to build 24 tiny homes by September 30, 2026, that will be utilized by the City to provide affordable housing to low-income residents.
 - 2. This resolution is subject to all City rules and regulations.
 - 3. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
