A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, NAMING THE PARK TO BE
LOCATED AT DAKOTA AND MILBURN AVENUES
"DOLORES HUERTA PARK"

WHEREAS, Dolores Huerta is an American labor leader and civil rights activist who, with Cesar Chavez, is a co-founder of the National Farmworkers Association, which later merged with the Agricultural Workers Organizing Committee to become the United Farm Workers; and

WHEREAS, Huerta has received numerous awards for her community service and advocacy for workers', immigrants', and women's rights, including the Eugene V. Debs Foundation Outstanding American Award, the United States Presidential Eleanor Roosevelt Award for Human Rights and the Presidential Medal of Freedom; and in 1993 was the first Latina inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, Huerta founded the Dolores Huerta Foundation with a mission to inspire and organize communities to build volunteer organizations empowered to pursue social justice throughout California's Central Valley; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the naming of the hereinabove-referenced park in honor of Huerta to be fitting in light of Huerta's contributions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council of the City of Fresno finds this action is necessary and appropriate in light of Huerta's contributions.

2. The City park to be located at the northeast corner of Dakota and Milburn Avenues shall hereafter be named "Dolores Huerta Park."

3. This Resolution is adopted in accordance with Section 8 of Administrative Order 6-2.

4. The provisions of Resolution No. 2020-272 shall be waived with respect to this Resolution.

5. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
