Dear Fresno City Council:

This letter is on behalf of the SEFCEDA's Board of Directors regarding the name change for the Ventura/Kings Canyon Boulevard alignment to "Avenida Cesar Chavez." It's the board of directors' opinion that there has never been a major corridor in the City of Fresno named after any historical Mexican-American who made a significant contribution that had bettered the lives for other people.

Cesar E. Chavez was a Mexican American labor leader and civil rights leader and military veteran who dedicated his life's work to improving the living and working conditions of farm workers in the United States. There are many instances in his historical journeys in which started here in Fresno, California.

It cannot be denied in those occasions his followers made major contributions to Fresno's economy. For these reasons Cesar Chavez's life and work had a profound impact on the people of Fresno. The insightful impression of this man gave notable reason to distinguish his importance that we celebrate his birthday on March 30 for the last twenty-five years. It was celebration of community service by giving of ourselves helping others. One of those events have been occurring every year at the Cesar E. Chavez Adult School Center. We have given freely.


SEFCEDA believes that the name change for the Ventura/Kings Canyon Boulevard alignment to "Avenida Cesar Chavez is a great name choice because it aligns with the City of Fresno's own specific plan for this corridor, which indicates that this corridor would benefit with a cultural identity.

Furthermore, over 79 percent of the residents living within the surrounding neighborhoods consist of residents with Spanish-speaking surnames. This and the fact that many of the business along this corridor are people of Hispanic origins, many who have at one point or another had supported the UFW.

Giving these facts what better way can a community begin to revitalize neighborhoods in the surrounding areas if not by first beginning it with community pride.

RE: The renaming of Kings Canyon, Ventura and California Avenues

The names KC, Ventura and California – are not offensive, divisive or accidental. They are inclusive and signify important natural resources essential to Fresno's founding and the religious values of the early colonies. They are important to Fresno's history and mark milestones in our diverse communities.

On March 9th, the renaming of Kings Canyon, Ventura, and California Avenues was placed on the Council's Consent calendar with no supporting citations and limiting public comment with a promise (to Vice-Chair, Perea) of another vote and continued community outreach before proceeding.

There has been: No Community outreach. No study. No notice to property owners and tenants. No environmental assessment. And, no fiscal impact considerations. This proposed project unnecessarily targets and burdens Fresno's oldest, historic, and most vulnerable minority communities of African Americans, Asians, Armenian, Hispanic and East Indian descent — all who have suffered indignities, genocide, redlining and hardships.

The Council's Workshop last July provided specific recommendations and guidance for the street renaming of Kings Canyon, Ventura, and California that included Public and Community Outreach and Planning Commission meetings with staff reports and environmental documentation – all of which were disregarded in this massive 10-1/2 mile "PROJECT on steroids" (Assistant City Manager Barfield) impacting 3,400 (not 3100) addresses including 1000 business/property owners.

Businesses and families already struggling to make ends meet and the additional burden on property owners and businesses in updating licenses, deeds, permits, records, registrations, passports, tax records and other agencies – is costly and time consuming.

911 emergency calls are experiencing high call rates for service and updating Fresno's 911 system and mutual aid response will cause long delays and confusion and puts families lives and communities at risk. Public noticing and community outreach after approval - is not due process.

Respectfully, I ask that you reconsider your actions and rescind the approval of renaming to ensure the process protects the historical significance of current street names and, community and neighborhood involvement is provided including, an environmental assessment and a deliberate process that includes alternatives.
