A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE BETTER BUSINESS ACT PROVIDING AN EXCEPTION FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING, SENIOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING, AND MIXED-USE PROJECTS WHICH BENEFIT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Better Business Act (the Act) was adopted by Council on May 21, 2009, and amended September 26, 2013, November 20, 2014, and January 14, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Council now wishes to amend the Act to allow for exemption for affordable housing and mixed-use projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The following language shall be added to Section 2 of the Act:

Affordable housing, senior affordable housing, and mixed-use projects for which the City is contributing funds from state or federal allocations to fulfill required health and safety related conditions of approval shall be exempt upon the adoption of a finding by the Council that the City contribution would benefit the public health, safety, and welfare.

2. This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
