**WHEREAS,** Kim Shehadey, a Central Valley native, graduated from California State University at Bakersfield with a degree in Early Childhood Development, and a degree in Business Administration from Santa Barbara Business College. This group’s programs include blanket making, sugar scrub, senior services, animal services, Poverello House volunteering, Operation Gobble and Beautify Fresno. The Assisteens® learn nonprofit skills with a governing board and develop philanthropic programs with her guidance; and

**WHEREAS,** Assisteens® are the driving force of Operation School Bell’s Super Saturday at Martin Luther King Elementary. One Saturday each month, Assisteens® and Martin Luther King students do homework, play sports and games, do arts and crafts, have story time, and eat healthy meals. This, along with Operation Gobble in Mike Karbassi’s district, are her favorite programs; and

**WHEREAS,** Kim’s true passion is Philanthropy. She exemplifies the Assistance League’s tagline which is “Transforming Lives • Strengthening Community”. She believes that hard work and time devoted to others is worth every minute. Her future goals are to continue teaching others to help themselves build up confidence so they can be happy and successful while simultaneously making Fresno a better place; and

**WHEREAS,** Kim’s family consists of her husband Jim and their 3 children: Audrey, Robert, and Lauren. World travelers, they are avid snow skiers and water enthusiasts enjoying boating and jet skis.
