This year, Trypticon and Bombshell have achieved remarkable success, securing over ten 1st place titles, four-level championship titles, and two grand championship titles, including The Quest National Championship. These championship-winning teams embody the spirit and enthusiasm of Fresno; and
- WHEREAS, the Quest, hosted by Varsity Spirit, is an exclusive event in Orlando, Florida at the ESPN Wide World of Sports at Disney World. The Quest is an invite-only competition featuring over 300 teams competing in different divisions. To earn an invitation, teams must secure a bid from a Varsity Spirit event held throughout the season. Teams are evaluated based on execution, technique, difficulty, and effective crowd-leading skills; and
- WHEREAS, both Trypticon and Bombshell won their respective bids and competed at The Quest National Championship. At The Quest, Fresno Elite Team Trypticon took 1st place in the nation, competing in the age group 14-year-old and under level 1 division, while Fresno Elite Team Bombshell took 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the nation, competing in the age group 10–18-year-old level 2 division.
