A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPEALING RESOLUTION CALIFORNIA, FRESNO, NUMBER 2024-052 AND AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING **PROHOUSING** DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY AND PROGRAM (PIP) ROUND INCENTIVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 2024-052 was adopted on March 7, 2024, authorizing application for and acceptance of funding from the California Department of Housing and Community Development Prohousing Incentive Program (PIP) Round 2 and authorizing the City Manager or designee to sign all necessary implementing documents, which resolution is now being repealed and replaced with this resolution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 50470 et seq., the California Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) is authorized to issue Guidelines as part of an incentive program (hereinafter referred to by the Department as the Prohousing Incentive Program or PIP); and

WHEREAS, the Department has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) Round 2 for approximately \$9,483,402.17 dated January 23, 2024, under the Prohousing Incentive Program (PIP) Guidelines and Application; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fresno, California, desires to submit a PIP grant application package (Application) on behalf of the City of Fresno (Applicant), an Eligible Applicant, on the forms provided by the Department, for approval of grant funding for eligible activities toward planning and implementation activities related to housing and

community development as a result of meeting eligibility criteria including, but not limited to, Prohousing Designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The Council of the City of Fresno has authorized and directed the City Manager of the City of Fresno, or designee, to sign and submit an Application on behalf of the City of Fresno as Applicant to the Department in response to the NOFA, and to apply for the PIP grant funds in a total amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.
- 2. If the Application for the PIP grant is approved by the Department, the City Manager of the City of Fresno, or designee, is authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver on behalf of the Applicant, a State of California Agreement (Standard Agreement) for the amount of \$1,500,000, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence, secure, and accept the PIP grant, the City's obligations thereto, and all amendments thereto.
- 3. The Applicant shall be subject to the terms and conditions as specified in the Guidelines and the Standard Agreement provided by the Department after approval. The Application and any and all accompanying documents are incorporated in full as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the Application will be enforceable through the fully executed Standard Agreement. Pursuant to the Guidelines and in conjunction with the terms of the Standard Agreement, the Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible uses and allowable expenditures in the manner presented and specifically identified in the approved Application.

4. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
