BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

Digester centrifugal pumps are vital to the wastewater treatment operation at the RWRP. The function of the pumps is to recirculate sludge through a heat exchanger to maintain proper temperature for the bacteria to digest organic materials, like a human stomach. The supernatant drain pumps are to transfer the sludge to a holding digester for the dewatering process. The Blackmer/Chesterton vortex pumps that are currently in place have been discontinued by the manufacturer and are not supported by the original manufacture or aftermarket suppliers. Wastewater operators are struggling to keep these pumps going by welding and or epoxy patch to hold pump housings together until we find a suitable replacement.
